



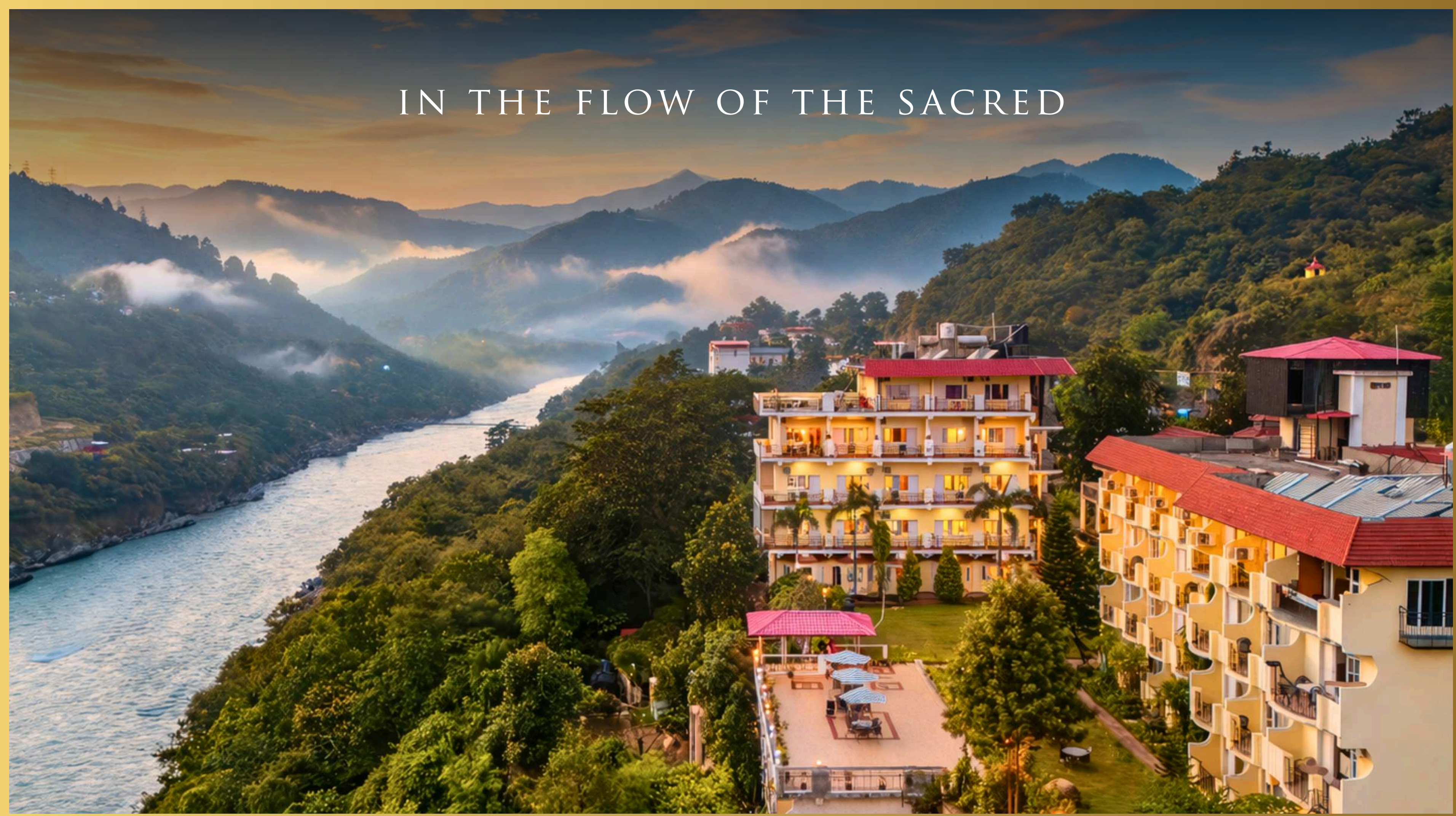

S R I N A G A R U T T A R A K H A N D

Once the capital of the Garhwal kings, Srinagar spreads along a broad bend of the Alaknanda, about midway on the old pilgrim road from Rishikesh to Kedarnath and Badrinath. It is a river town with a university's easy energy — ringed by holy confluences, ancient Shiva temples and forested hills. For travellers on the Char Dham, it is the natural pause: close to everything, yet unhurried, green and cooled by the water.

DHARI DEVI TEMPLE

Guardian of the Garhwal Himalaya, Maa Dhari Devi presides from a raised platform set in the middle of the Alaknanda at Kalyasaur. One of the 108 Shakti Sthals, her shrine holds the upper half of the idol; the lower half is worshipped at Kalimath. Locals say the goddess's face shifts through the day — child, woman, elder — and that she watches over the Char Dham itself.

DEVPRAYAG SANGAM & RAGHUNATH TEMPLE

The last of the Panch Prayag, where the green Alaknanda and the blue Bhagirathi braid together and, from this point on, are called the Ganga. Stone steps drop from the old town to a triangular Sangam ghat; above it stands the Raghunath Temple, tied in tradition to Adi Shankaracharya over a thousand years ago. Quiet, unhurried, and genuinely moving.

KAMLESHWAR MAHADEV TEMPLE

In the heart of old Srinagar stands one of Uttarakhand's oldest Shiva temples, counted among the five Maheshwar Peethas of the Himalaya. Legend has Lord Rama offering a thousand lotuses here in penance. On Kartik Chaturdashi, couples keep an all-night lamp vigil — a rite for the blessing of children — and Shivratri brings a spirited fair to the lanes.

ALAKNANDA RIVER RAFTING

The resort sits on one of Garhwal's finest stretches of white water. The Alaknanda runs clear and fast past Srinagar, its rapids threading between forested banks and open sky — bracing, scenic and suited to first-timers and seasoned paddlers alike. Runs are arranged in the cooler, drier months when the river is at its best; monsoon flows are given a wide berth.

ON THE DOORSTEP

Best Sep–Jun · river-dependent



TEHRI LAKE & DAM

Asia's tallest dam holds back a vast emerald reservoir ringed by bare Himalayan ridges. The water is the draw: boating, kayaking and jet-ski runs from the Koti Colony shore, with the sheer wall of the dam as backdrop. A long, winding mountain drive — and worth it for the sudden scale of open water high in the hills.

45 KM · 1.5–2 HRS

Best Oct–Jun · water sports daily

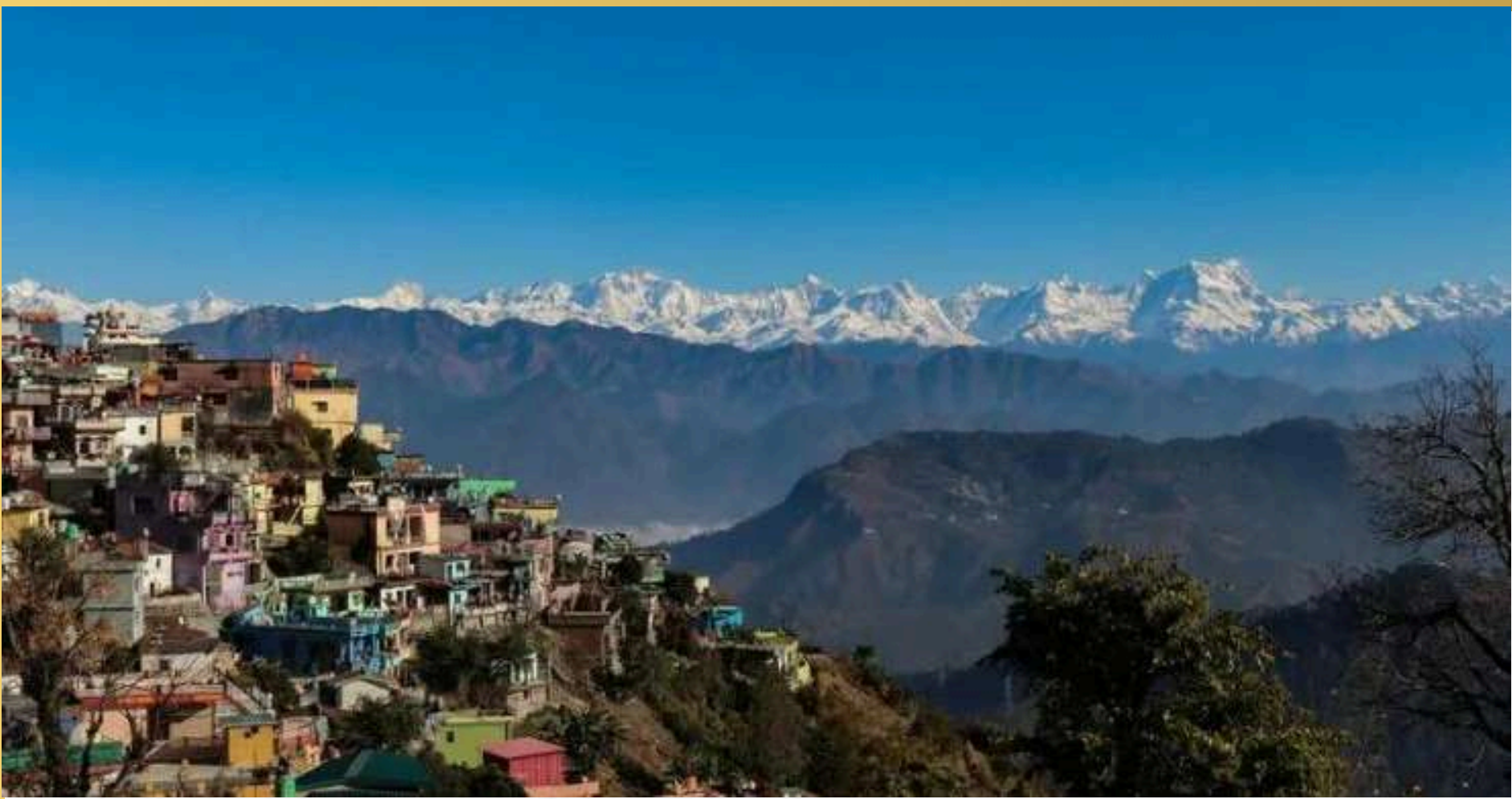


KHIRSU

A hushed hamlet at around 1,700 m, wrapped in oak and deodar and edged with apple orchards. On a clear morning it opens to a near-180° wall of snow peaks — Chaukhamba, Nanda Devi, Trishul — with almost no crowds to share them. The old Ghandiyal Devta temple sits nearby. Come for birdsong, cool air and a horizon that runs for miles.

40 KM · 1.5–2 HRS

Best Mar–Jun & Sep–Nov



PAURI & KANDOLIYA

The district town of Pauri climbs the hillside above the Nayar valley, with the Kandoliya temple and park just beyond it. From this vantage the Garhwal giants — Chaukhamba, Trishul, Nanda Devi — line up across the skyline, best at dawn. Pine forest, a small ropeway and easy walks make it a relaxed half-day in the high country.

30 KM · 1–1.25 HRS

Clearest peaks Oct–Nov

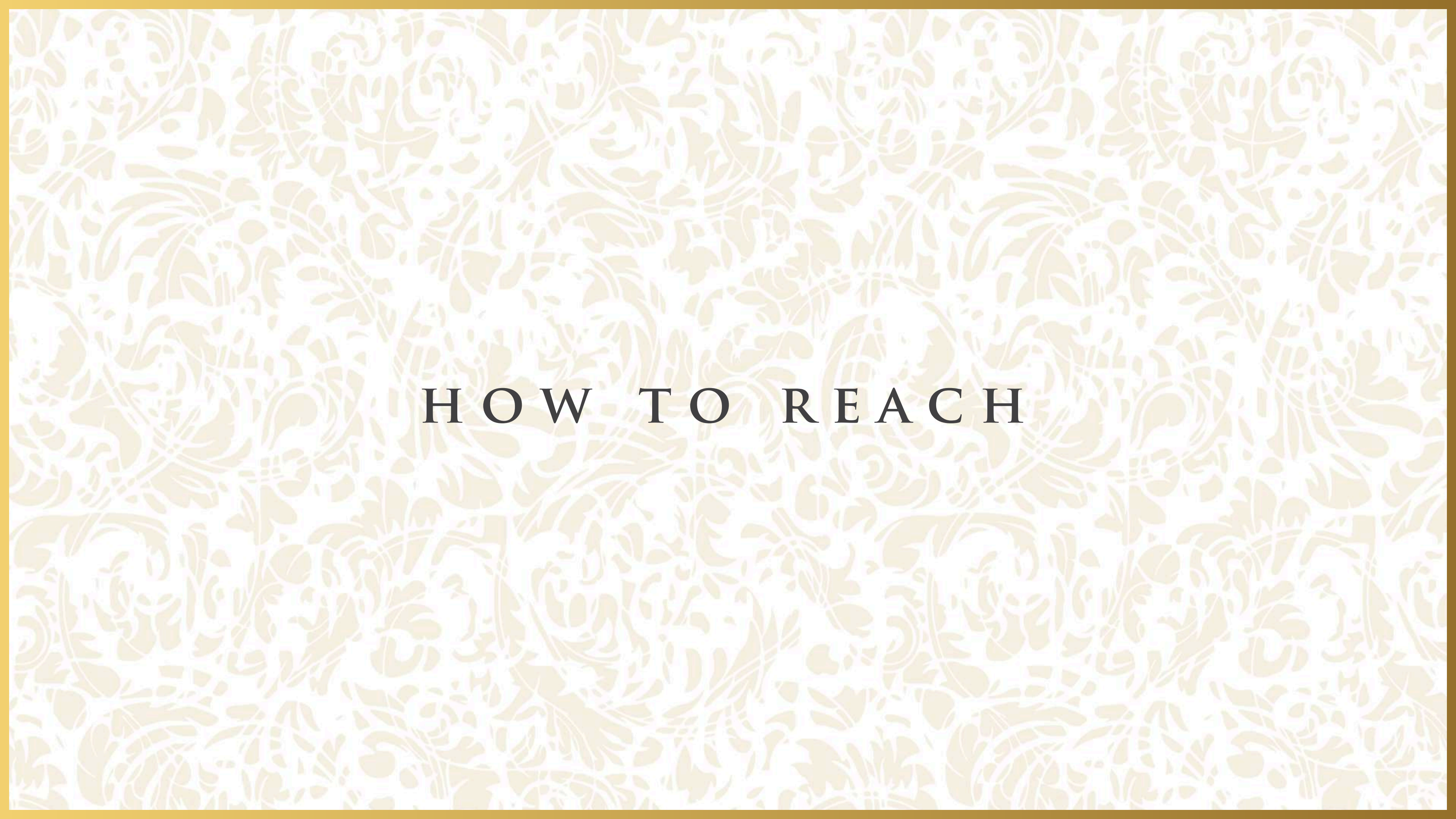


MALETHA VILLAGE & THE ANCIENT CANAL

The resort's own village carries a four-hundred-year-old story. Madho Singh Bhandari, a 17th-century Garhwali general, cut an irrigation channel — the Maletha ki Kool — through hard rock, tunnel and all, to bring water to these once-parched fields. Folklore tells of a father's terrible sacrifice to set the water flowing. It runs to this day.
